Sealed proposals will be received by the Construction Manager – Graham Construction at Greater Regional Health (the “Hospital”) 1700 West Townline, Creston, IA on 19th day of June, 2019 at 2:00 PM and opened at 2:05 PM the same day in the Conference Room on the 1st Floor of the Medical Arts Plaza Conference Room for furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment for Bid Packages (01) thru (03). The proposals will be presented to and considered by the Board of Trustees of the Hospital during a board meeting at 6:00 PM CST on Monday, June 24, 2019 at Greater Regional Health Medical Arts Plaza (MAP) Conference Room. Such proposals received will be acted upon at such time and place or at such later time and place as may then be fixed.

A pre-bid conference/site walk will be held on Monday, June 03, 2019 @ 10:00 am in the Medical Arts Plaza Conference Room, Greater Regional Health, 1700 West Townline, Creston, IA 50801.

DESCRIPTION: Furnish all labor, material and equipment required to accomplish the construction described in the specifications, indicated on the plans, and according to the schedule. The work includes, but is not limited to, the renovation/addition of ground level for Pharmacy, MAP vestibule, Rehab, and Cardiac Rehab. Also, first floor office space renovation along with upgrade to adjacent finishes.

BID SECURITY: All bids must be accompanied by bid security payable to OWNER in an amount equal to at least 5% of the highest total amount including Add Alternates. The bid security may be in the form of a Certified Check, Cashier's Check or a bid bond executed by corporations authorized to contract as surety in the State of Iowa. The bid bond shall be executed by the Bidder on AIA Bond Document. Bid Security shall be in a separate envelope with the sealed bid and shall be forfeited to the Owner as liquidated damages in the event the bidder fails to enter into a contract and furnish a bond within ten days after his bid has been accepted. No Bidder may withdraw his bid for at least sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids the 19th day of June 2019.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish and pay for satisfactory Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price. Bond to be issued by a responsible surety approved by the Board of Trustees of Broadlawns Medical Center.

The Notice to Proceed will be issued following acceptance of the executed Contract by the successful Bidder and the requisite Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond and insurance certificates, and a determination by the OWNER that it has secured permanent financing for the Project. All work for this package shall be completed within the given schedule.

QUALIFICATIONS: The Owner reserves the right to request qualification forms before issuing documents or before Contract is awarded, and to further reject any or all proposals or to waive technicalities or irregularities and to accept any bid which will best serve the interests of the Owner. By virtue of statutory authority, a preference shall be given to products and provisions grown and coal produced within the State of Iowa.
